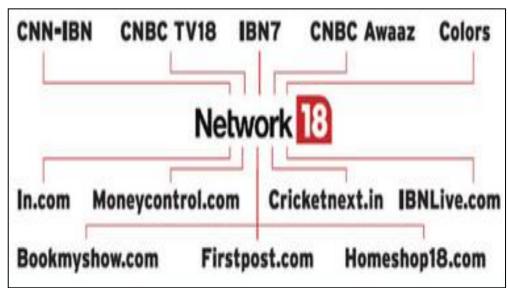

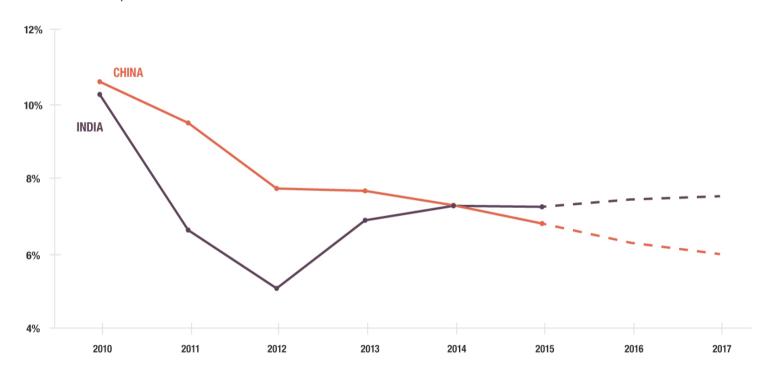








#### INDIA IN THE LEAD REAL GDP GROWTH, IN PERCENTAGES
