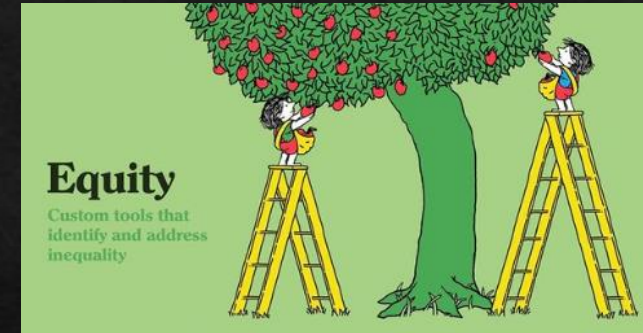


Multisectoral Collaboration and HiAP Approach towards *Health Equity*: Thailand Experience

National Health System Charter 2022

“A framework and guideline in making health related policies and strategies”

Concept – Good governance for health system focusing on:

- 1) HiAP and participation;
- 2) enabling and empowering environment/ecosystem for ‘health’; and
- 3) development of human capability

*Goal – “Equitable health system” or “Health equity”:
“leaving no-one behind”*

National Health Assembly

“A framework and guideline in making health related policies and strategies”

A process at national level in which the *public, related state agencies, and other sectors participate, exchange their knowledge and cordially learn from each other* through an organized forum leading to recommendations of healthy public policies or public healthiness.
